THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

There are ways families can celebrate the season of Advent:

An Advent wreath consists of a frame holding four candles placed inside a circle of evergreens. The greenery in the wreath symbolises the promised new life

The four candles denote the four Sundays of Advent. There are three purple candles and one rose candle. Purple is a sign of penance and rose is the colour denoting the anticipation of joy.

Light a candle on each Sunday evening of Advent, saying a short prayer or singing a verse of 'O Come, O Come Emmanuel' The light of the candles represents the light coming into the world as we prepare to celebrate Jesus'
