FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 25th November – St Catherine of Alexandria, virgin and martyr - St Catherine was martyred in 310 at Alexandria. Her body is venerated at the monastery on Mount Sinai

Optional St Clement 1 pope and martyrthird successor of St Peter as Bishop of Rome. Optional St Colman. Born around 530. probably in West Cork, a bard by profession reputed to have been influenced by St Brendan

Wednesday 27th November - St Fergal (Virgil) lived first in France and then in Bavaria. where the founded the monastery of Chiemsee. He was appointed Bishop of Salzburg around 754 and died in 784. leaving a reputation for learning and holiness.

Saturday 30th November – St Andrew

Apostle - St. Andrew's feast is a signal of the beginning of Advent (plus or minus a few days). From Bethsaida was a disciple of St John the Baptist when he was called by Jesus. He in turn brough his brother Peter to Jesus. He is said to have suffered martyrdom on this date by crucifixion but the tradition of an X-shaped cross is much later. Patron of Scotland, Russian and fisherman.
