FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 12 August - St Jane Frances deChantal married at age 20 left a widow with four children after 9 years. Her friendship with St Francis deSales led to the foundation of the Congregation of the Visitation.

Wednesday 14 August - St Maximilian Kolbe, priest and martyr - a Conventual Franciscan who worked in the apostolate of the press in Poland and Japan, and died in Auschwitz.

Thursday 15 August - The Assumption of Mary honours the fullness of blessedness that was her destiny, the glorification of her immaculate soul and virginal body that completely conformed her to the risen Christ. This is a celebration that offers to the Church and to all humanity an exemplar and a

consoling message, teaching us the fulfilment of our

highest hopes

Saturday 17th August - Our Lady of Knock. The story off Knock began on 21 August 1879 when Our Lady, St Joseph and St John the Evangelist appeared at the south gable of Nock Parish Church. This miraculous apparition was witnessed by fifteen people, young and old. Knock is an internationally recognized Marian Shrine. Saint John Paul II visited Knock as part o his 1979 papal pilgrimage to Ireland. Pope Francis went to Knock and prayed at the Shrine before the final Mass of the World Meeting of Families at the Phoenix Park, Dublin on Sunday 26 August 2018. Pope Francis, on the Feast of St Joseph, 19 March 2021 declared Knock to be an International Shrine of Eucharistic and Marian Devotion.
