FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 10 June St Columba, Derry

and Raphoe - also known as Colum Cille born in Gartan Co Donegal. He was noted for his great love for people and all living creatures.

Tuesday 11 June – St Barnabas was born on the island of Cyprus. He was one of the first converts in Jerusalem and preached at Antioch. He became a companion of St Paul and went with him on his first missionary journey and he took part in the Council of Jerusalem. He returned to his native land to preach the Gospel and died there.

Thursday 13 June - St Anthony of Padua, priest and doctor of the Church - St

Anthony lived for a time in France, but chiefly in Italy, and died at Padua in 1231 at age 36, with the reputation of great sanctity. From the day of his death innumerable miracles caused the faithful to invoke him as a wonderworker of untiring benevolence. Anthony is one of the most popular saints in the Church.

Friday 14 June St Davnet, Virgin - lived and died at Tydavnet at Sliabh Beagh Co Monaghan. Tradition speaks of St Davnet as a virgin and found of a Church or monastery.
