FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday May 27 - St Augustine of Canterbury, Bishop was a monk in Rome when sent by Pope Gregory the Great to preach to the English.

Wednesday 29 May St Paul VI, Pope: born 1897. Ordained priest 29 May 1920 and worked in Vatican for most of the time before becoming archbishop of Milan in 1954. Elected Pope in 1963, taking the name Paul VI, succeeding John XXIII, he continued the second Vatican Council. A messenger of peace, he sought to pen the Church to the modern world; he began the papal apostolic visits. He was Beatified in 2014, canonised 2018, his memorial is on the anniversary of his priestly ordination.

Monday 29 May - The Blessed Virgin Mary Mother of God

From the cross Jesus entrusted Mary to his disciples as their mother and entrusted his disciples to Mary as her children. Mary, present with the disciples at Pentecost prayed with them as the Holy Spirit descended. Mary has never ceased to take motherly care of the pilgrim Church on earth.

Thursday 30 May - The sacrament of baptism bestows the universal priesthood of believers. **Friday 31 May** - The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Today's liturgy recalls the 'Blessed Virgin Mary carrying her Son within her' and visiting Elizabeth to offer charitable assistance and to proclaim the mercy of God the Saviour.
