native of Leinster. Wishing to be a hermit, he crossed mountains to Glendalough and settled in Disert Caoimhahin. The monastic settlement grew and spread through the glens.

Tuesday 4th June - Saint Charles Lwanga and Companions, twenty-two Ugandan youths martyred in 1886.

#### Wednesday 5th June - St Boniface,

Bishop and Martyr, was born at Credition in Devonshire and educated in monastery schools in England. He founded monasteries in Bavaria.

## Thursday 6 June - St Norbert an St Jarlath, Bishops - St Norbert was the
