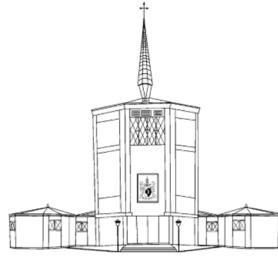

FEAST DAYS DURING THIS WEEK

Monday 18th November – Dedication of the Basilicas of Ss Peter and Paul. The dedication of the churches of St Peter and St Paul was observed on this date since 12th century. The present basilica of St Peter's was consecrated in 1626 and St Paul's Outside-the-Walls in 1854.

Thursday 21st November – The Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary This feast celebrates Mary in her grace-filled life, wholly given over to the Holy Spirit
Friday 22nd November – St Cecilia, virgin and martyr

- the patroness of music and musicians was a second or third-century Roman Christian martyr. According to tradition, she refused to worship the Roman gods and was beheaded.

Saturday 23rd November: St Columban (also known as Columbanus), abbot and missionary - He became a monk of Bangor and later principal teacher there. In 591, desiring to 'go on pilgrimage for Christ', he set out with twelve companions and came to Burgundy. He established monasteries at Annegray, Luxeuil and Fontaine according to the severe Irish rule. Later he founded Bregenz in Austria and his greatest foundation oat Bobbio, near Genoa, where he died in 615. He is remembered as one of the greatest of the Irish missionary monks.
